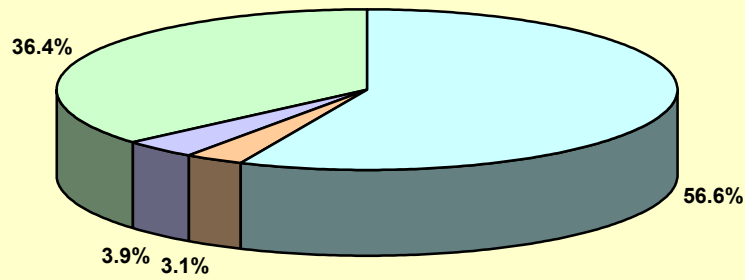
### Estimated Tourist Expenditure (US\$mn)



### Jamaica: Total Visitors

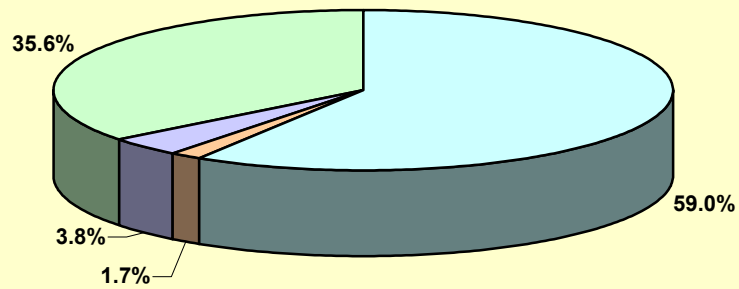


### Composition of Visitors June 2004

### Composition of Visitors June 2005



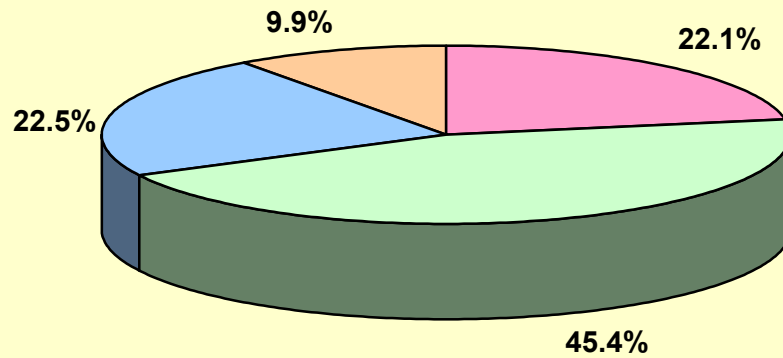

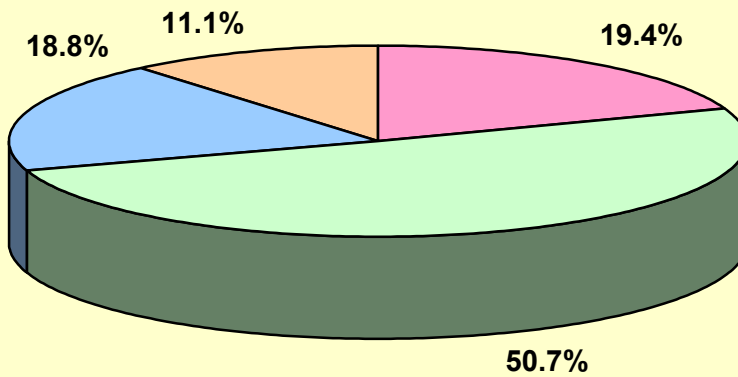
